In 2018 CEPM initiated and launched the world's first 100% objectively assessed International Project Management Team Excellence Award (I-PMTEA) competition. This competition is assessed on each team's performance in two real time computer-based simulations that require numerous complex decisions to be made by the team.

I-PMTEA competition is globally the only award based on 100% objective assessment depending on the score achieved by each team in 2 leading separate Project Management Simulations from Prendo, UK. Each team performance is independently assessed in UK. The first simulation is related to Managing Stakeholders (Copper mines with 12 stakeholders from 7 countries) and the second simulation is demonstrating Project Leadership (Building a giant stadium in 24 months in under 50 million pounds).

This year I-PMTEA 2024 Competition is being held in both Physical and Virtual Modes.
Physical mode in New Delhi for teams from India and Virtual mode for teams from outside India.

- The team scoring then **highest score** will be the Winning Team and shall lift the **I-PMTEA Winners Trophy** plus a set of 6 classic books on project management and a Citation will be given to each team member.
- The team with the **second highest score** will lift **I-PMTEA Runner-up Trophy**, plus a set of 3 classic books on project management and a Citation will be given to each team member. The team with the **3rd highest score** will lift the **CEPM 2nd Runner-up Trophy** plus each team member will receive a set of 2 classic books on project management and a Citation.
- The Team from the **public sector undertakings scoring the highest marks** will lift the Standing Conference of Public Enterprises (**SCOPE**) **Best CPSU Team Trophy** plus a set of 2 classic books on project management and a Citation to each team member.
- Amongst the teams from the various **IOC Directorates**, the team getting the highest score will lift the **i2P2M Best IOC Directorate Team Trophy** plus a set of 2 classic books on project management and a Citation to each team member.

Global Symposiums on Project Management held annually since 1992 and the World Project Management Forum (WPMF) since 2019

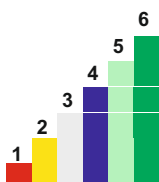
